Sydney Again Voted One of World's Best Cities

Sydney is continuing its reign as one of the World's Best City according to the well-travelled readers of *Travel+Leisure* magazine.

The Harbour City has another top ranking on the list of top 10 Cities Overall in the prestigious World's Best Awards survey.

Minister for Tourism and Major Events, George Souris, has announced that Sydney has been voted the number one city in Australia, New Zealand and the South Pacific and is ranked number five on the list of Top 10 Cities Overall in *Travel+Leisure* 2012 World's Best Awards readers' survey. Last year, Sydney ranked number eight among cities worldwide in the survey.

"Sydney has now been selected by *Travel+Leisure* readers as the top Australasian city for 17 years," Minister Souris said.

"Again this traveller survey demonstrates Sydney's international reputation as one of the world's premier destinations," Mr Souris said.

The latest *Travel+Leisure* award comes in a long list of international honours Sydney has collected in the last 18 months, including number one city in the *Condé Nast Traveller* Readers' Choice Awards, *Lonely Planet's* World Best Summer City award and world's best festival and major events city by the International Festival and Events Association.

Destination NSW Chief Executive Officer, Sandra Chipchase, said the latest award was another endorsement by travellers who had experienced first-hand all that Sydney has to offer.
